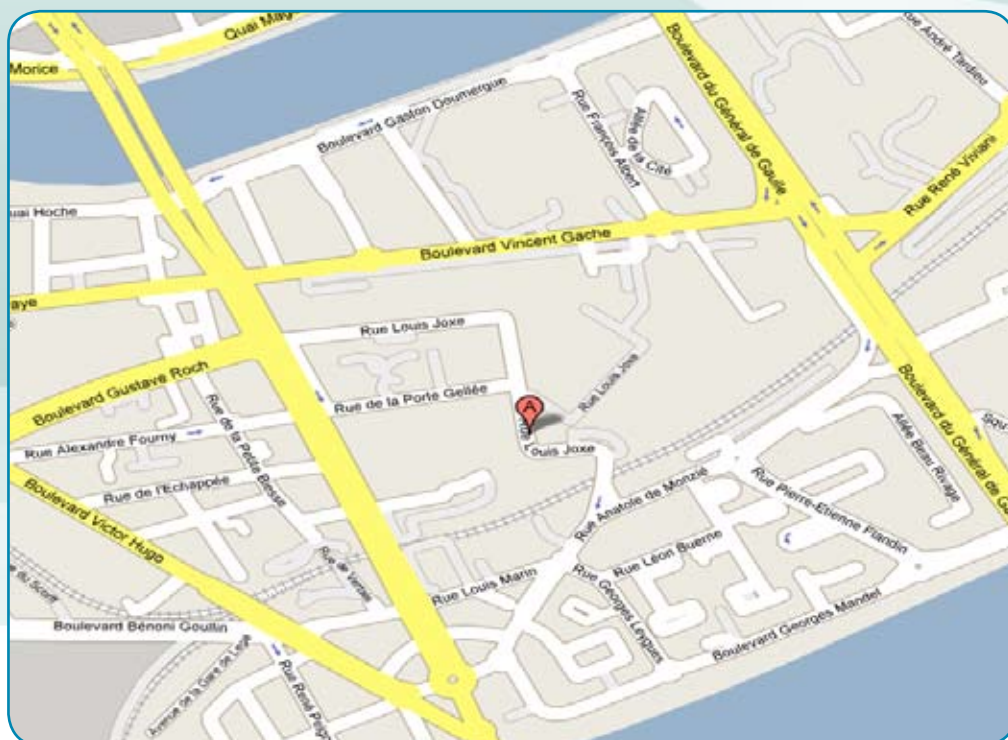
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MAPS AND DIRECTIONS





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▶ NANTES AIRPORT

The **Nantes Atlantique Airport** lies just South of Nantes and is the leading airport in the west of France.

The **TAN Air bus shuttle** runs to the City centre in about 20 minutes. Tickets from/ to the airport (7 Euros) can be bought onboard the buses and are valid for one hour throughout the local TAN public transport network.

There is also a regular bus route (bus number 37) running from the Airport to the Tramway Line 3 at Neustrie station.

Take the bus 37 outside the Airport Terminal and going towards Croix Jeannette. Stop at Neustrie 5 minutes later.

At Neustrie, take tramway 3 (Direction Sillon de Bretagne) and stop at Wattignies Station where the tournament hall is located. For bus fare, please click on the «Public Transportation» icon on the World Cup page on the ITSF website.

A taxi stand is located just opposite the entrance door of the airport terminal. A taxi ride to downtown Nantes takes around 10 to 15 minutes and costs between 25 to 35 Euros, depending on the distance and the time of day. For reservations call +33 (0)240 69 22 22.

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▶ NANTES BY TRAIN

SNCF is the French national train company.
You can book your tickets on its website.

Nantes is located at only 2 hours from the centre of Paris (Montparnasse station) by the high speed train (TGV) which runs every hour.

Also the TGV runs straight from the Roissy-Charles de Gaulle international airport to Nantes city centre in 3 hours. The Roissy-Charles de Gaulle station is located inside the airport. The train to Nantes runs 4 times a day.

The journey by TGV from Lyon (Lyon Part Dieu train station) to Nantes lasts 4 and a half hours - with approximately 5 trains per day.

Many other train lines go to Nantes from the main French cities and from abroad.





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▶ NANTES PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

TAN is Nantes' bus company.

They run buses, tramways and ferryboats («navibus»).

The TAN tickets are valid for Nantes and its suburbs on the whole transportation network : bus, tramway, busway (special bus line n°4) and navibus. So make sure you take time to visit Nantes on the rails, on the streets and on the water!

STANDARD TICKETS

Valid for 1 hour after punching

Single Ticket : € 1,50

10 tickets : € 12

SPECIAL FARE TICKETS

We recommend you use these special tickets in particular on the week-end, especially if several people travel together:

24 Hour Ticket For One Person : € 4

Valid for 24 consecutive hours after punching for 1 person.

24 Hour Ticket For 4 People : € 6,50

Valid 24 hours OR Saturday+Sunday after punching for between 1 and 4 people traveling together.

Don't forget to punch your ticket in the machine when getting on board!
